When we understand the process of meaningful conversations as a series of connected phases (“breaths”), we see that each must somehow feed into the next.</p>	<p>A visual representation of a participatory process:</p> <p>This includes both what we are going to do during the process and how we are going to work together.</p>	<p>A specialized technique for capturing (in real time) the essence of conversations in images and keywords:</p> <p>Sometimes known as Strategic Illustration.</p>	<p>When preparing to host conversations that matter, you should pay particular attention to the quality of the space and - devil being in the details - to logistics.</p>
